1. Activities reflecting the goals and objectives of the institution

Shri G. K. And C K Bosamia College is one of the premiere educational institutes providing higher education for over more than 38 years. The basic objective of the college is to provide higher education to the students of Jetpur Taluka in the field of Commerce, Arts, Management and IT. Assurance of quality and dedication in teaching is the “Mantra” of the institution.

Followings are the Activities reflecting goals and objectives of the institution:

- National level seminar in commerce is jointly organized with Indian Accounting Association.
- The symposium on "Late Gujarati Poet Shri Nitin Mehta's literary contribution" was organized by Gujarati department.
- One day workshop for principal and faculties of 30 colleges of Saurashtra University was organized to orient them towards CBCS system.
- BISAG (Bhaskaracharya Institute for Space Applications & Geo-Informatics) system, from state government is installed and regularized in the central library.
- Various programs are performed and numbers of the students and all the faculties have participated under state government "Swarnim Gujarat Saptdhara"
- Organized a Student workshop on "*Co-operation*" by District cooperative society.
- Established Separate infrastructure for MSc. IT program
- Inauguration of "*AUMKAR BHAVAN*"; The Auditorium cum gymnasium, also functioning as a multi utility hall for various sports, cultural and co-curricular activity.
- To raise awareness against "*Swain-Flue*", the college organized a campaign for several days in Jetpur city as well as 20 villages of the taluka.
